

Queree

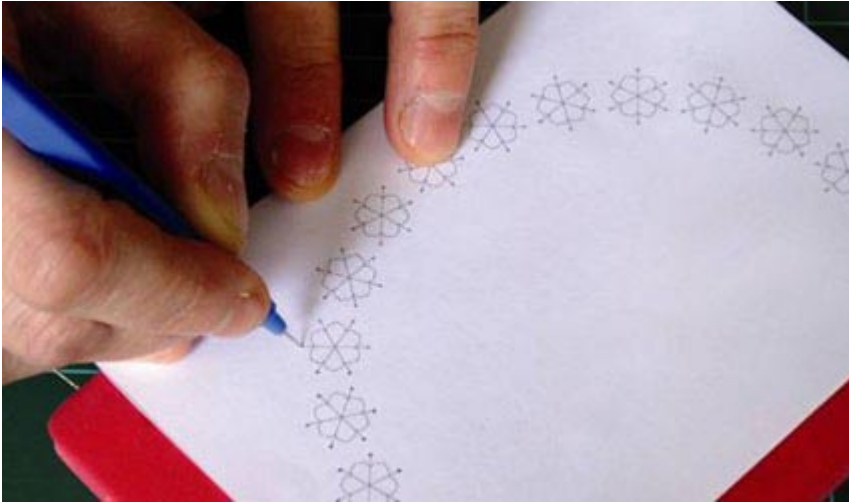

Work method:



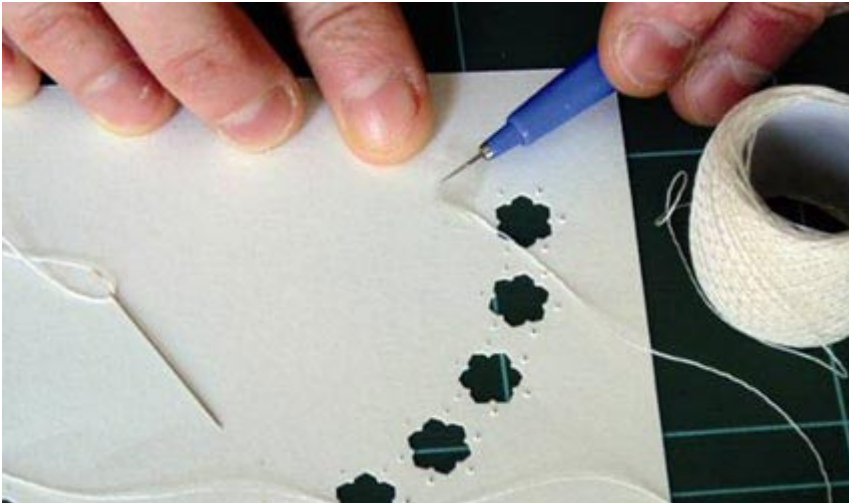
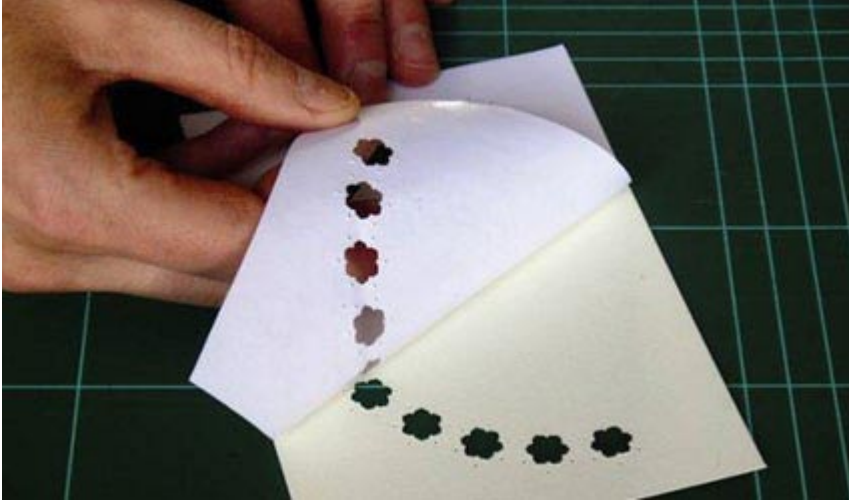
1. Materials: Queree punch, copy of pattern from booklet, card paper, embroidery thread, thin needle and non-permanent glue.

2. Put some dots of the non-permanent glue 118038/0418 on the back of the pattern. Leave to dry well, until the glue is transparent!



3. Prick the holes with a thin pricking tool, follow the pattern exactly.

4. Punch the shapes with the punch, follow the pattern exactly.



5. Remove the pattern from the card.

6. Start and finish your thread with a piece of cello tape, never with a knot!



7. Start stitching and make sure that no “double-back” threads are visible through the shapes. If need be secure the thread with a small piece of cello tape or stick the card onto the second card first and prick the holes again. It’s a little more work but you won’t have to pay attention to those “double-back” threads.

8. Now finish the card.
